

September Progress Reports

Additionally, grades on this progress report are based on minimal assessments. As more assessments are completed, the grades on subsequent progress reports may change from those on the September progress report.

Grades from specials (art, library, music, and physical education) are based on an E/S/N scale rather than the A/B/C/D/F scale. In specials, grades of 90%-100% are marked as E, grades of 70% to 89% are marked as S, and grades below 70% are marked N.

ONLINE RESOURCES

ST Math may be accessed at stmath.com. Students learn a 13-character "picture password" at school which then allows them to access this resource on web-enabled devices with screen sizes of 7" or larger.

myON may be accessed at clarkmyon.com. Students use their CCSD student ID number as their username and password. This resource must be accessed on a desktop or laptop. Once accessed via a desktop or laptop, students can locate their unique PIN from the website that will then allow them to use myON on a tablet device.

Students use typing.com to practice keyboarding skills. Being good at keyboarding supports students in achieving mastery of standards and in demonstrating proficiency on state assessments. Go to typing.com and use student credentials from school.
