## NEWS AND NOTES

Our school will continue to receive support through Title I in the 2019-2020 school year. Our allocation is \$124,410.00 which is a significant increase from the previous years as we moved from Tier 3 to Tier 2 status within the Title I program. In addition, there is an additional allocation of \$1,244.10 for parent involvement activities. These funds support the programming in the school and the items funded through this program impact all children both directly and indirectly.

The School Organizational Team will hold the February meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 6, 2019, in the school library. The 2019-2020 School Plan of Operation will be presented which includes the Strategic Budget and School Performance Plan. The 2019-2020 Title I budget will also be presented. These items were approved by the School Organizational Team at the January 30, 2019, meeting.
