Report cards for the first semester of the 2020-2021 school year are now available online in the Campus Parent portal. Please note, printed copies of report cards will not be distributed due to updated CCSD procedures. Please take a few minutes to review the information in this letter along with reviewing your child's first semester report card information in the Campus Parent portal.

## **Campus Parent Portal Information**

Go to <https://campus.ccsd.net/campus/portal> and log in with your Infinite Campus username and password. If you do not recall your username and/or password, you may recover your information by using the Forgot Username or Forgot Password recovery links found on the Campus Parent login page. If that does not work, please call the front office at (702) 799-5760 between 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to request your credentials be reset. Look for report card information in each subject and/or in Documents.

## **Semester 1 Report Card Information**

For all students, please be advised that this report card at Semester 1 is a mid-year report of progress made so far. All grades remain active in the grade book and are considered as part of the end-of-year grades at the end of Semester 2. Students who are struggling at this point still have half the school year to improve their grades. Conversely, students with high marks must continue to work hard to maintain those high marks for the remainder of the year.

All students will have information about attendance (days enrolled and days participated) in the upper right-hand corner. Comments from the teacher are located below attendance information.

## **Information About Classroom Content Areas Grades & Marks**

- Kindergarten students do not receive letter grades. Rather, they receive grades of 1 (Approaches) or 2 (Meets) only. Blanks in Overall Grade boxes in kindergarten mean that the teacher had insufficient evidence of achievement and was not able to assign a grade.
- Any blank sections in the area with classroom subjects not listed as Overall Grade have not been taught yet and will not have a mark.
- For students in Grades 1-5 who did not submit a sufficient amount of tasks to the teacher, affected classroom subjects will have a grade of "I" in Overall Grade which means that the teacher had insufficient evidence of achievement and was not able to assign a grade.

## **Information About Grades In Special Subjects and Successful Learner Behaviors**

- If there is a blank in either of these two sections, a student did not submit a sufficient amount of tasks to the teacher (both through participation in synchronous activities and completion of asynchronous tasks). A blank in a special subject or in a learner behavior means that there was insufficient evidence of achievement for a grade or mark to be issued.
- Explanation of Grades/Marks
  - E=Exceptional Progress
  - S=Satisfactory Progress
  - N=Needs Improvement
