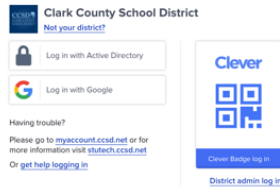




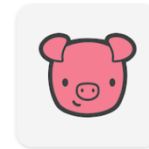
Welcome to Freckle for Clark County Students and Families

Log in with Clever

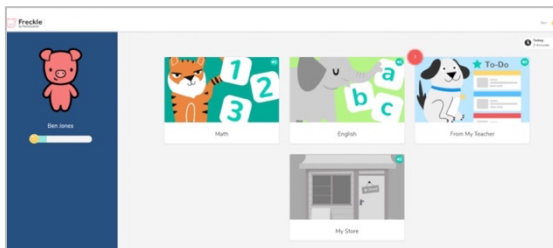


Log in through your Clever Portal.

Students in Kindergarten – 2nd grade



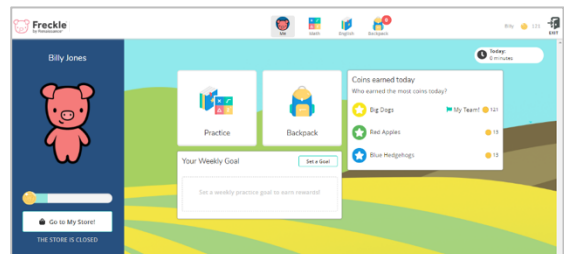
Your dashboard

- Once you log in, you will see your dashboard. It will look like the picture above.
- Choose the **Math** tile to practice number basics and math facts, learn basic number facts, and explore math concepts.
- Choose the **English** tile to explore new words and books, learn and review site words, explore literacy skills, and read or listen to new texts.
- If your teacher has an assignment for you, it will be in the **From My Teacher** tile.

Earning coins for practice

- When you practice, you earn coins.
- When you start earning coins, the progress bar below your avatar will start filling. When it is full, your **My Store** will open and you can go shopping to dress up your character.

Your dashboard

- Once you log in, you can see your dashboard and click on your tiles.
- The **Practice** tile will allow you to work on any practice activity in Math or English.
- You can also click on the **tabs** at the top of your screen to see the Math and English options to practice.
- The **Backpack** tile will include assignments from your teacher.

Earning coins for practice

- When you practice, you earn coins.
- When you start earning coins, the progress bar below your avatar will start filling. When it is full, your **My Store** will open. Just click the button below your progress bar and go shopping to dress up your character.

When you finish using Freckle for the day, just click EXIT in the top corner of the screen.
